The Government of the Republic of Cyprus, within the framework of its efforts to promote the creation of the Cyprus Science Technology Park (STP) for development purposes in the Pentakomo area, Limassol district, invites interested parties for an Initial Expression of Interest regarding the following:

- > (i) Initial Expression of Interest from Enterprises/Organizations that wish to be accommodated and develop activities in the STP.
- > (ii) Initial Expression of Interest from Investors that wish to undertake the establishment and operation of the STP.





Fields of Activities

The STP could host:

- Applied research and academic centres,
- Business incubators and clusters,
- Actions of the city/park of knowledge (related to the Digital Strategy of Cyprus) and other knowledge-based enterprises, organizations and institutions.

Indicative fields of activities include knowledge intensive areas, for example Information Communication Technology, Energy, Nanotechnology, Health and Biomedicine, Agriculture and Food, Environment and Water.

General Planning Principles

The total area under expropriation for the STP is about 324.000 square meters (m2) and its development may include:

- i. Main facilities, such as university departments, research centres, business incubators, enterprise development areas, business centres.
- ii. Ancillary facilities and supporting services for the needs of the STP activities only, such as offices, retail units, sports, leisure, entertainment and possibly, accommodation facilities.
- iii. Necessary infrastructure such as roads, electricity and communications substations, water supply stations and sewage treatment plants and any other facilities/structures that could be considered necessary for the proper operation of the Project.

Basic Utility Services


- The main phase of the construction of the access road to the STP (excluding asphalt paving and signage/marking), that connects the Governor's Beach Area with the Saint George Alamanou Area along the coast, as well as the onsite alignment of the internal road network of the Park, have been completed.
- Arrangements for basic utility services, such as water and electricity supply, sewage and communication services, shall be clarified at a later stage, following an analysis of the results of the "Initial Expression of Interest" and possibly during the next official invitation of interest, tender procedure and/or during the next stage of promotion of the Project.
